Open Dutch Championship and Coen Gülcher Memorial

Flying Junior Class and Flying Dutchman Class

organised by Koninklijke Watersport-Vereeniging 'Loosdrecht'

under the auspices of the RNWA

from 17 to 18 (inclusive) October 2020

location: Loosdrechtse Plassen

[SP] denotes a rule for which a standard penalty may be applied by the race committee without a hearing”

1 RULES

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)*.

1.2 The 'Rules for Championships Sailing, Windsurfing and Kiteboarding' will apply.

1.3 The sailing instructions may change other rules as well.

1.4 Spare

1.5 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

1.6 Every person on board who has his domicile in the Netherlands shall have the appropriate license.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

3.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the Flying Junior and Flying Dutchman class.

3.2 Eligible boats may enter before 10 October 2020 at the following website: www.kwvl.nl.
The required fee shall be paid via iDeal.

3.3 Late entries will not be accepted.

6 SCHEDULE

- 6.1** Registration: Due to COVID-19 there will be no physical registration. Competitors that have entered for the event and will not attend are asked to send a 'no show' e-mail to wedstrijden@kwvl.nl.
- 6.2** Equipment inspection and event measurement:
During the event an equipment and measurement can be held at random.
- 6.3** Dates of racing:
October 17 and 18 are racing days for FD and FJ.
- 6.4** Number of races:
There are 7 races scheduled for both classes.
- 6.5** The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race is 10.55 hrs.
- 6.6** On the last day of the regatta no warning signal will be made after 15.00 hrs.

7 MEASUREMENTS

Each boat shall produce a valid measurement certificate.

8 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available after 20 September on the website of the KWVL at www.kwvl.nl.

10 THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be an Olympic Triangle.

11 SPARE

12 SCORING

- 12.1** Four races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 12.2** (a) When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- (b) When 5, 6 or 7 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.



- (c) For the ranking in the Coen Gülcher Memorial, a boat's serie score will be the total of her races scores.

13 [NP][DP] SUPPORT BOATS

Support boats shall be marked with RC.

14 BERTHING

Boats shall be kept in their assigned places at the marina of the Yachtclub.

17 [NP][DP] RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats.
VHF will only be used for safety communication.

18 PRIZES

The crew of the winning boat acquires the title "Dutch Champion"

The RNWA supplies for the winning boat or team a blue pennant and a medal for every member of the crew of the first three boats or crews (there will be no extra medals available for changes in the crew during the championship).

For the Coen Gülcher there will be prizes available for the crew of the first three boats.

19 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

20 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of Euro 1.500.000 per incident or the equivalent.

21 RIGHTS TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS

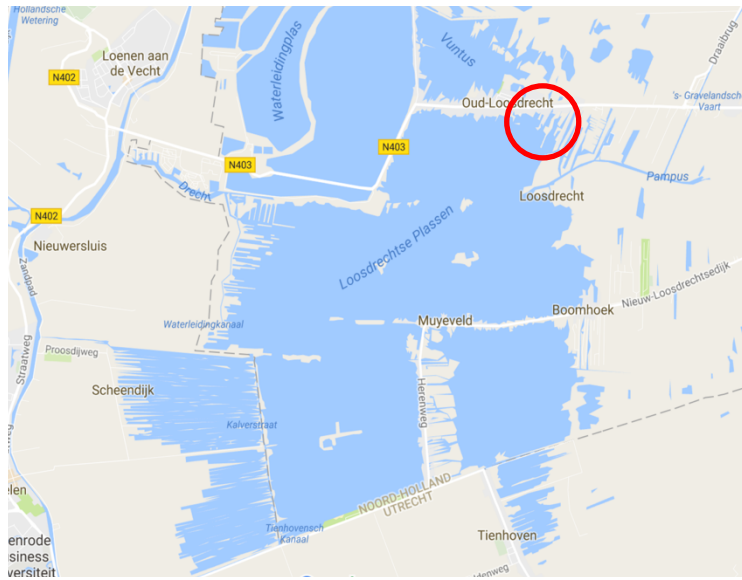
