The notation '[NP]' in a rule means that a boat may not protest another boat for breaking that rule. This changes RRS 60.1(a).

**1 RULES**

- 1.1 The event is governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)*. The Prescriptions of the RNWA can be found at <https://www.sailing.org/inside-world-sailing/rules-regulations/racing-rules-of-sailing/>
- 1.2 The 'Rules for (Open) Championships Sailing, Windsurfing and Kiteboarding' (available at <reglement-voor-kampioenschappen-20191101-v5-docx.pdf> (<watersportverbond.nl>)) will apply.
- 1.3 Racing rule(s) 29.1 will be changed as follows: After a general recall the new start will be 5 minutes later. The changes will appear in full in the sailing instructions. The sailing instructions may change other rules as well.
- 1.5 If there is a conflict between languages the text in the English language will take precedence.
- 1.6 Every person on board who has his domicile in the Netherlands shall have the appropriate license.
- 1.7 RRS Appendix P applies.

**4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

- 4.1 The event is open to all boats of the ILCA class(es).
- 4.2 Boats may enter the event by registering online before October 22<sup>nd</sup> at the website [www.kwvl.nl](http://www.kwvl.nl).
- 4.3 To be considered an entry in the event, a boat shall complete all registration requirements and pay all fees. Payment is done via an iDeal payment.
- 4.4 Late entries will not be accepted.
- 4.5 The following restrictions on the number of boats apply: *There is a maximum of 90 boats in order of entry.*

5.1 The entry fee is € 45,00 per boat.

## 8 QUALIFYING SERIES AND FINAL SERIES

8.1 When on the closing day more than 30 boats have entered, the event will consist of a qualifying series and a final series.

**The qualifying races are on Saturday 29 October. And the final races on 30 October.**

There are 8 races scheduled each day. 16 in total.

9.4 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first day is 10.55 hrs and on Sunday the time for the warning signal is 09.55 hrs.

9.5 On the last day of the regatta no warning signal will be made after 16.00 hrs.

## **15 SCORING**

**15.1** Four races are required to be completed to constitute a championship.

- 15.2**
- (a) When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
  - (b) When 5 up and till 12 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
  - (c) When more than 12 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

**15.3** RRS 90.3(e) applies.

## **16 [DP] SUPPORT PERSON VESSELS**

**16.1** Support person vessels shall be marked with the sailnumber of the supported boats.

## **21 DATA PROTECTION**

**21.1** By participating in this event, competitors automatically grant to the organizing authority and the event sponsors the right, in perpetuity, to make, use, and show, at their discretion, any photography, audio and video recordings, and other reproductions of them made at the venue or on the water from the time of their arrival at the venue, until their final departure, without compensation.

## **22 RISK STATEMENT**

**22.1** RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.

**22.2** The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

## **23 INSURANCE**

**23.1** Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of Euro 1.500.000 or the equivalent per incident.

## 24 PRIZES

24.1 The RNWA supplies for the winning boat or team a blue pennant and a medal for every member of the crew of the first three boats or crews (there will be no extra medals available for changes in the crew during the event).
